## Rick's Ramblings

### Grow as Stewards through Faith, Love and Hope!

The theme for this year's stewardship program beginning on November 5, is titled "Grow as Stewards through Faith, Love and Hope!". In his letter to the people in Thessalonica, Paul wrote, *"We continually remember before our God and Father your work produced by faith, your labor prompted by love, and your endurance inspired by hope in our Lord Jesus Christ" (1 Thessalonians 1:3)*. God graciously gives us faith, love, and hope – virtues essential in our lives as Christians and as God's stewards. Each week during this three-week program, we will be focusing on one of the triads of faith, love, and hope.

In week one, we are reminded that it is through faith that we have access into God's grace and a new relationship with Him. Not only does faith justify us and give us peace with God (*Romans 5:1*), Paul tells us in our theme verse that faith produces works. Faith leads to action. Through faith, we are empowered to fulfill God's purposes. Our deeds as stewards are evidence of our faith.

During the second week we will focus on the virtue of love. Love seeks the welfare of others *"... since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us" (1 John 4:11-12)*. God's love in Christ will compel us to do things that appear foolish to unbelievers. God's love prompts us to give freely of our prayers, presence, gifts, and service to help others and extend God's kingdom.

The third and final week we will bring focus on the virtue of hope. Through the resurrection of Jesus, we, as believers, are given victory over death and assurance of our salvation. Filled with the hope of eternal life, "here on earth as it is in heaven", with Jesus, we *"give [ourselves] fully to the work of the Lord, because [we] know that our labor in the Lord is not in vain" (1 Corinthians 15:58)*.

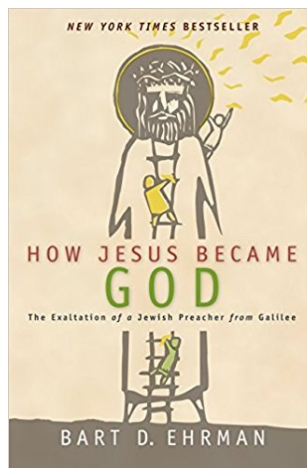
