We would like to expand our service to local retirement centers, nursing homes, veteran's hospitals, etc. So we need more boots on the ground! Please call me if you have any questions.

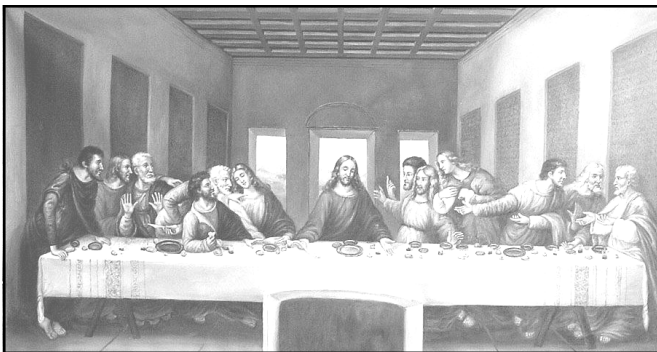

The Tuesday Women's Bible Study group will prepare and serve a Continental breakfast and a light lunch, available at nominal cost.

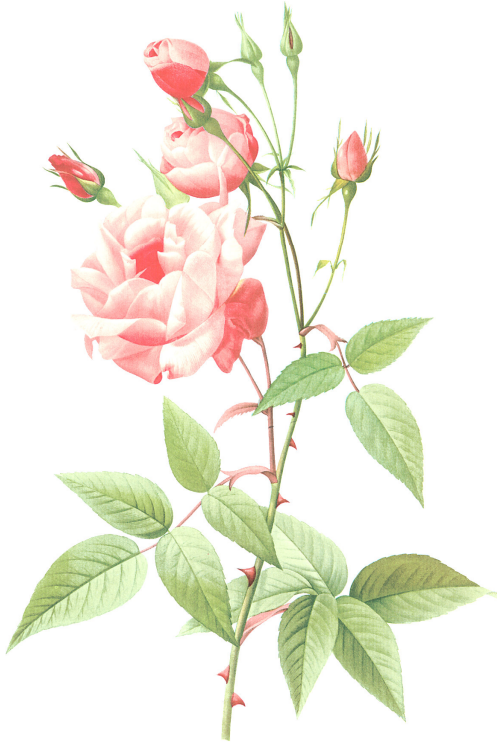

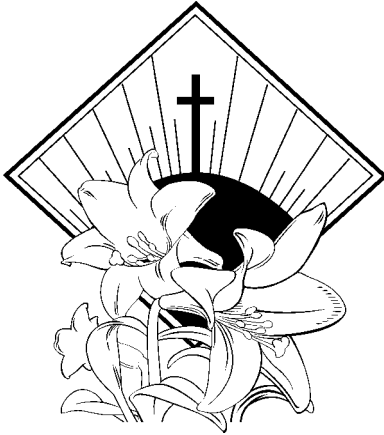
